Not AKC registered???? – NO PROBLEM!!!!

You will be able to register your Canine Partner with AKC at the event and your dog can participate in the tests that very same day. *If you are also registering your Canine Partner with AKC, simply fill out the Canine Partners Enrollment Application located at the end of this premium list and turn it in at the Field Secretary's desk on the day of the test along with your entry form and fees* (Payment is made directly to AKC. Fill out the credit charge authorization on the Canine Partners form or include your check payable to AKC).

INSPECTION

Once entered, Report to Inspection Desk at any time during the hours listed on the front of the premium list for the test you have entered with your dog for check-in and inspection. Each dog will be inspected by the committee for lameness, fitness to compete, and females in season.

RUN YOUR DOG

Once your dog has passed inspection, he will be placed on the running order list, (first come, first served) which will be posted near the test area. **OWNERS/HANDLERS MUST ARRANGE SOMEONE TO HELP THEM WITH CATCHING/RELEASING THEIR DOG ! ! ! !**

****NOTE: The Club requires a minimum of 1 hour between runs of any dog entered in both trials on Saturday.******

COLLARS/TAGS

Dogs may wear any collar except a choker collar, a collar with prongs or an electronic training collar. The collar should be snug to minimize the chances of getting hung up on something during the run. Owners should be aware that tags hanging from the collar could be required to be secured to the collar to help prevent their being entangled on something during the run. Owners may use clips or rubber bands to hold the dog's hair. The owner assumes responsibility for the safety of the dog with regard to the dog's collar and paraphernalia on the dog



? ? WHAT'S IT ALL ABOUT ? ?

FAST CAT IS A TIMED 100-YARD DASH AFTER A LURE PAST A START LINE AND OVER A FINISH LINE. Dogs run singularly and are released on the start line by an owner or handler and caught at the finish by another person familiar with the dog.

****OWNERS/HANDLERS MUST ARRANGE SOMEONE TO HELP THEM WITH CATCHING/RELEASING THEIR DOG!****

Each dog's run is recorded to the nearest 1/100th second.

CAN MY DOG EARN AN AKC TITLE?

YES !!

Titles are earned by accumulating points. The time of the dog is converted to MPH and multiplied by a potential handicap based on the dog's height to determine titling points. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers.

*18" or greater – handicap is 1.0 (i.e., no handicap)

*12" up to less than 18" – handicap is 1.5

*below 12" – handicap is 2.0

Titles that can be earned:

BCAT – 150 points

DCAT – 500 points

FCAT – 1,000 points

FCAT followed by a number (e.g., FCAT2) for every additional 500 points.

In addition to titles, the Top 20 fastest dogs by Breed are tracked by AKC. Standings are updated as event results are processed throughout the year. *Please visit the AKC website for a complete set of Fast CAT rules: <http://www.alkc.org/events/fast-cat/>.*

NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

- This property is a pasture field, Approx. ½ mile from county road, and is field fenced.
- Dogs will run down a taped track.
- Electronic timers will be used.
- This property has no amenities or shade available. Please ensure the comfort of you and you dogs by bringing your own portable shade/shelter and water.
- Portable restrooms will be made available.
- Refreshments Snacks or Lnch will not be available. We encourage you to bring your own.
- All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the test.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered.
- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form.
- All dogs to be inspected for each test and must be presented WITHOUT TAPE, BANDAGES or WRAPPING on the toes, feet, or legs. Committee members may request that cold-weather coverings such as blankets, coats and pajamas be removed from dogs under inspection.
- Field Committee Members, Volunteer Trial Workers may have their dogs inspected prior to the designated inspection time by the full inspection committee.
- Dogs not present at the time of Roll Call will be scratched and entry fees will not be refunded
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be refused entry and, if presented at inspection, will be refunded entry fees.
- Monorchid and cryptorchid dogs may be entered.
- Spayed or neutered dogs may be entered.

- Dogs disqualified by an event committee are not allowed to participate.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC/AHCoA/any dog(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site.
- The event-hosting club, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators.

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

From San Antonio/downtown Austin: IH 35 North to Exit 240B (US 183 North). US 183 North 38.6 Miles. East (right) onto County Road 221 – Gate is ½ mile on right

From Houston: US 71 or US 290 Westbound. TX-130 Toll North (24 mi if coming from US-290; 36 mi. if coming from US-71). Exit TX 195 North (Florence/Killeen). Left (N) over Freeway onto TX 195, 14.4 mi – *****NEW** Take Lampasas, HWY 138 exit*** - Left (W) over freeway onto Hwy.138 towards Lampasas– 7 miles to US 183. Left (S) onto US 183 – continue ¼ mile. Turn East (left) onto County Road 221 – Gate is ½ mile on right

From Dallas/Ft.Worth: IH 35 Southbound to Exit 293A Right (W) onto Hwy. 190 towards Killeen – continue 18 miles to Hwy. 195 exit. Turn left (S) onto Hwy. 195 towards Florence – continue 19.5 miles to Hwy. 138. *****NEW** Take Florence Business Exit***. Right onto Hwy.138 towards Lampasas– approx. 7 miles to US 183 (dead end) Turn South (left) onto US 183 towards Austin – continue ¼ mile to County Road 221. Turn East (left) onto County Road 221 – Gate is ½ mile on right
